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2- Parents queries -----

The school receives phone calls every day, only from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. to be informed of an absence or an urgent subject.

- The teachers of all classes receive you by appointment according to the schedule indicated in the respective circulars to the cycles, which will reach you later through the school application. Please respect it.

3- After Class Support (Accompagnement Après Classe (AAC) -----

The *After Class Support (AAC)* study service resumes this year. This service supervises only the daily school agenda.

Place: School campus in Hazmieh

Time: Every working day from Monday to Friday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Fees: 1,500,000 L.L. / month

N.B. AAC doesn't provide private lessons.

4- School Schedule -----

- Classes start at 7:30 a.m. in Jamhour and at 7:35 a.m. in Hazmieh. Students arriving late without a valid excuse do not enter class for the first period.
- Various appointments (doctors and others) should be avoided during school hours, especially on exam days. If necessary, the students stay at home all day, and present a valid justification the next day.
- If a student needs to exceptionally leave the school by Taxi, parents must notify the school in advance by indicating the name of the driver or the taxi office, in addition to the name of the student(s) concerned to gain access to the campus. Otherwise, the taxi will be prohibited from accessing it.
- Classes end at 2:10 p.m. in Jamhour and at 2:30 p.m. in Hazmieh.

5- Application of the School: "Antonines Hazmieh-Jamhour" -----

The school posts all circulars, sheets, agendas, report cards, holidays / news / information on the school's application. There will be no paper version.

9- Tuition and Certificates/Attestations -----

Annual school tuition fee is billed in 3 installments.

You are requested to pay it within the deadlines indicated in the invoice to Mrs. Samia Moukarzel (Hazmieh) or Mrs. Liliane Aoun (Jamhour) any day during school hours.

© Certificates/Attestations are issued at least 48 hours after your request, and transcripts at least 5 working days after your request.
